- Design and teach curricula to heterogeneous classes of English language learners of many academic levels, languages, and cultures.
- Link subject area curricula to the school's themes and incorporate discussion of current events, hands-on experiences in the community, and meaningful connection to students' interests and experiences.
- Create project-based curricula and use performance-based assessment.
- Use inquiry-based approach to teach interdisciplinary classes.
- Provide specially designed and/or supplemental instruction (SETTS) to support the participation of the student with a disability in the general education classroom
- Work with multiple teams of teachers of various disciplines to plan content and language instruction and create a supportive community for our diverse students. Also, work collaboratively with other teachers to design curricula and assessments, and to support each other in improving teaching practices.
- Teach community building, identity development, reflective writing, and interest exploration.
- Participate in developing and implementing Work Based Learning Opportunities with our Literacy Team.
- Interest in obtaining a Work Based Learning Extension Certificate.
